Every year, around 2200 students take admission in the college out of which approximately 1000 students pass out as conscientious, determined, noble and disciplined citizens. The college provides a home away from home for those hailing from remote areas. It can boast of a safe, airy and spacious hostel providing comfortable accommodation to more than 225 girls in the current session. The session 2021-22 started on October 11, 2021 with Dr. Neeta Mittal as Officiating Principal.The college faculty comprises assiduous and experienced 111 members of which as many as 42 have done their Doctorates and 19 have done M.Phils. The faculty is supported by an industrious team of 41 technical and non-technical employees.

indu Girls College has one unit of NCC comprising 106 cadets to instill a sense of national unity, social cohesion, dutifulness, and community development by participating in social programmes and following a regimented lifestyle. NCC Unit of the college comes under 12 Haryana Battalion NCC, Sonipat and Ambala Group of Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh and Chandigarh Directorate.

The college has NCC as an extra-curricular activity. NCC enrolls 30-35 fresh cadets of First Year on voluntary basis every year (for a period of 3 years) after conducting a series of tests on medical fitness, physical fitness and a written test based on general awareness. he library is fully equipped and facilitates complete support to students. It is a computerized library with a collection of 35,702 books during 2020-21 which was increased to 36,096 books in 2021-22.

The library has 1334 reference books.

The library has a subscription of 19 newspapers and 54 magazines and journals. Star collection includes Encyclopedia in 35 subjects.

The library issues 4 books to U.G. Students and 6 books to P.G. Students at a time. On an average 160 books were daily circulated.

The Book- Bank service granted 3,680 books of different subjects to 718 meritorious students during the year 2020-21 and 6,000 books of different subjects to 608 meritorious students during the year 2021-22. 395 books worth Rs. 1,24,714 are added in the current academic year.

The library provides OPAC search and Indexing services for books and magazines respectively to both students and staff.

The library provides digital facility of N-LIST (INFLIBNET) which provides e-journals and ebooks that are easy to access and download by the students and the staff.

Books are arranged by DDC (Dewey Decimal Classification).

Librarian, Mrs. Seema Rani conducted a Library and Digital Library Literacy Programme for the first year students of various courses and introduced them to the various services provided like searching techniques, mode of accessing digital resources and other rules and policies of the library.


